## Notes to BCIBC Accounts for 2023/24

Despite a decrease in membership numbers, the Club made an operating profit of £1,297.33. This was after having paid for 2 items of extraordinary expenditure amounting to £514.08. The introduction of The Hub coffee bar proved very successful, showing a net profit of £1,715.62 as well as providing a more 'club like' atmosphere for members to enjoy.

I would like to draw members' attention to the following:

- 1. **Legacy Leisure.** We are awaiting payment of our share of Woodgreen Membership Fees and Rebate of EIBA Levy, total £3,485.15 so we have withheld Rink Fees of £637.40 pending settlement of this account. The balance of £2,847.75 has therefore been treated as a net debtor.
- 2. **Charity.** Income does not include proceeds of the Charity Match postponed from 31 March 2024 until 14 April 2024.
- 3. **Signwriting and Bowls Pushers/Jacks.** These are the 2 items of extraordinary expenditure referred to above.
- 4. **Banking.** 1.05% interest on Hampshire Trust Fixed Rate Bond which expired 2 July 2023. Balance of capital plus interest, total £56,275.62 subsequently invested in a new 2-Year Fixed Rate Bond @ 4.20% AER with first interest payment due July 2024.
